### Am I a Candidate for iLASIK?

Most people with common vision problems can benefit from iLASIK vision correction. The best way to understand your options is to consult with your ophthalmologist. In the meantime, answering a few simple questions will help get you started.

### What Conditions Prohibit iLASIK?

iLASIK is contraindicated for people with autoimmune or immunodeficiency disease, corneal thinning, significant dry eye, severe allergies, or a history of herpes simplex or herpes zoster keratitis. Women who are pregnant or nursing should wait due to possible fluctuations in vision. Certain medications may also make you ineligible, so talk to your eye doctor.

### Is My Vision Stable?

If you're 21 or older, in good health, and haven't had noticeable changes in your vision for at least a year, you may be a candidate for iLASIK.

### What Vision Problems Are Improved With iLASIK?

The iLASIK custom procedure can help correct nearly all common causes of ordinary vision impairment, including:

- myopia (nearsightedness)
- hyperopia (farsightedness)
- astigmatism (abnormal curvature)

More than 91% of iLASIK patients are able to achieve 20/40 to 20/20 vision or better, and many are able to greatly reduce or eliminate their need of corrective lenses.
